RULES & REGULATIONS

PRIZES: 1st Place - \$300, 2nd Place - \$100, 3rd Place - \$50

1. Each contestant is required to bring 6 gallons of chili. There is no entry fee.
2. Each contestant is to prepare the chili and bring it to the event. The chili must be prepared in a certified kitchen.
3. Each contestant is required to bring a portable heating device to keep your chili hot. Open flame devices fueled by propane are not permitted. Crock pots, chafing dishes and/or thermal containers are recommended.
4. The Ice Blast committee will be providing tables, serving spoons, 4 oz sample containers, bowls (for chili purchases), crackers, and ballot boxes.
5. Each contestant will provide free samples consisting of 4 oz servings.
All entries must have titles and be edible.
6. Condiments such as cheese or sour cream are permitted.
7. Ingredients must be written down; portions may be omitted in the case of secret recipes.
8. The chili contest will take place from 5:30 to 7:00 p.m. Contestants will need to arrive between 4:30 and 5:00 p.m. for set up.
9. Judging of the chili will be as follows: Each patron entering the contest area (i.e., the tent) will receive a ticket for voting purposes. Each chili serving station will have its own ballot container. Once a patron samples the entries, they will then place their ticket in the ballot container located at the Positive Results, PRIDE table to vote for their favorite entry no later than the start of the 1st period. The contestant receiving the most tickets by the end of the contest will be deemed the winner. The winning entry will be announced in the arena during the first period of the hockey game.
10. Contestants must notify the Ice Blast Committee no later than 5:00 p.m. on Sunday, the 1st of February if they wish to enter. Space is limited.
11. Flyers advertising your business are permitted.
12. Contestants will receive two Spirit tickets and one parking pass free of charge for the game following the contest.
